	e. Cllr G Peachey – Beck Row Parish Council. Cllr G Peachey discussed the collaborative opportunities between Beck Row PC and West Row PC. The discussion was centered around the possibility of joining forces in certain areas to enhance efficiency and service delivery for both communities. The focus was on the potential for sharing the Parish Keeper, a role integral to the maintenance and upkeep of parish assets and public spaces.

463	<u>Matters Relating to Street Furniture/Amenity Provision</u> a. Report on Speed Indicator Device Findings. SID stats remain consistent. b. Update on Footpath 30 (eroded riverbank) along the river at bottom of the Gravel. Ongoing. c. SCC Development – Commencement of the works has been delayed and will begin within the next few months, d. Building site at the entrance to Pott Hall Road – Cllr A Fisher has spoken to WSC regarding the site and awaiting a response. e. New Cemetery – (a) the archaeological survey proposal was approved by SCC and has been accepted by WSC. That means we are now good to go with the survey in the new year. The provisional dates for the dig are the 8 th and 9 th January 2026. (b) at this point it now makes sense to apply to WSC for planning approval to comply with some conditions that were attached to our original planning consent. The only outstanding document we need to do this is the soft landscaping scheme, so Cllr M Peachey has requested 4 quotes from Landscape Architects to draw this up for us. Cllr M Peachey proposes that we	

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	<p>accept the lowest quote and submit the application when ready. (c) Bendall & Sons solicitors have been engaged to act for us in the purchase of the cemetery land from SCC, they are currently awaiting the sales contract from SCC's legal department. Overall Cllr M Peachey is pleased with the progress being made and the project is going to plan.</p> <p>f. Pott Hall Road – SCC will be doing a speed survey from 14th October to 21st October 2025. Cllr R Hamill will again endeavor to sign up residents to the speed watch group.</p> <p>g. Community Road Safety – Joining forces with Moulton Parish Council to challenge SCC about their current stance on road safety, speeding and traffic calming. Cllr R Hamill attended a meeting earlier today which was very well attended. Follow up meeting will take place in the near future.</p>	
464	<p><u>Other Working Party Updates/Reports</u></p> <p>a. Update to the Echo/Parish Magazine. It was decided to bring the printing of the next edition forward by one week.</p> <p>b. Update on Neighbourhood Plan – the plan has now been submitted to WSC by our consultant. They will now consult on it, after which it will be reviewed by an independent examiner, and finally go to a local referendum. This is a very long process, but we are getting there slowly.</p> <p>c. Warm Places Update. Expenses update. Next fish and chip lunch Friday 31st October 2025. Christmas Lunch has been booked for Friday 12th December 2025 at £30 per person. We have just received an additional £1,500.00 from Community Action Suffolk.</p> <p>h. 100 Club Update – Sue Spencer won this month's prize draw of £74.00</p>
